The AAP-OC Chapter is participating in the ACEs Aware Round 3 known as the Preventing and Responding to ACE-Associated Health Conditions and Toxic Stress in Clinics through Community Engagement (PRACTICE) Grant. Efforts are being led by Be Well Orange County in collaboration with several Orange County community-based organizations, physicians, and partners.

AAP-OC will be conducting a **Resiliency Quality Improvement Project** to promote the ACEs Aware initiative among pediatric providers in Orange County. ACEs Aware seeks to change and save lives by helping providers understand the importance of screening for ACEs and training them to respond with trauma-informed care.



The AAP-OC invites you to join this 4-month project from September 2023 – January 2024, to incorporate resiliency practices into your clinics while screening for ACEs. Providers will have the opportunity to participate in four monthly sessions learning how to incorporate resiliency into their practice and to utilize resources such as OC Findhelp to make patient referrals.
